



Electric Air Compressor Safety

1. Never drill into, weld or make any modifications to the tank or its attachments.
2. Never use the compressor to inflate small low-pressure objects such as childrens toys, footballs, basketballs, etc.
3. Always operate the compressor in a well-ventilated area free of combustible materials, gasoline or solvent vapors.
4. Never operate compressor outdoors when it's raining or wet.
5. Never operate compressor with guards or protective covers that are damaged or removed.
6. Always wear safety glasses with side shields when using the compressor.
7. Never direct air steam at people or animals.
8. Never inhale air from the compressor either directly or from a breathing device connected the compressor.
9. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly installed and grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.
10. Use only 3-blade extension cords that have 3-blade grounding-type plugs and 3-slot cord connectors that will accept the plug from the product. Use only extension cords having an electrical rating not less than the rating of the product. Do not use damaged extension cords. Always shut off the air compressor switch before removing the plug from the receptacle.
